Role:

The successful candidate will facilitate the Gender Journey Brant peer support group. The role of the peer facilitator is to provide peer support to Trans and gender non-conforming identified adults in the Brantford-Brant area. This position is an opportunity to become more engaged in and support the Trans, and gender non-conforming community in Brantford/Brant.

Responsibilities:

- Organize and facilitate bi-monthly peer support groups
- Direct conversations and encourage participants to support one another, redirect conversations when needed
- Communicate with supervisor if any issues arise during group
- Maintain a clean physical space at the end of each session
- Ensure the group norms are adhered to at all times and ensure sessions remain on time
- Engage the group and manage conflict using a collaborative approach
- Provide peer support to members of the trans community of Brantford/Brant
- Attend volunteer orientation and role specific training
- Notify supervisor in advance if unable to be present for group
- Opportunity for other duties

Skills and Qualifications Include:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Trans or gender non-conforming identified
- Social and group facilitation skills
- Ability to make others feel comfortable with demonstrated empathy and sensitivity
- Problem solving skills
- Have attended Gender Journey Brant is an asset
- ASIST, safeTALK and Mental Health First Aid training is an asset
- Training will be provided for peer facilitation and conflict management training
- Police check with vulnerable sector screening required

Time Commitment:

- 2 shifts per month
- 1.5-hour shifts
- Minimum 1-year term

Benefits:

- Expand your social and professional network

- Apply your experience in the community
- Gain experience with facilitation skills, problem solving or learning through others' experiences
- Orientation, specific training as deemed appropriate for role and staff support provided
